- 6. What have been your experiences in risk-taking and change?
- 7. What might you pray about after seeing this video and having this discussion?
- 8. How can you as an individual or congregation support Extraordinary Lutheran Ministries and the leaders in Proclaim?
- 9. What actions steps will you take as an individual or congregations after seeing this video?
- 10. Who else should see this video?
